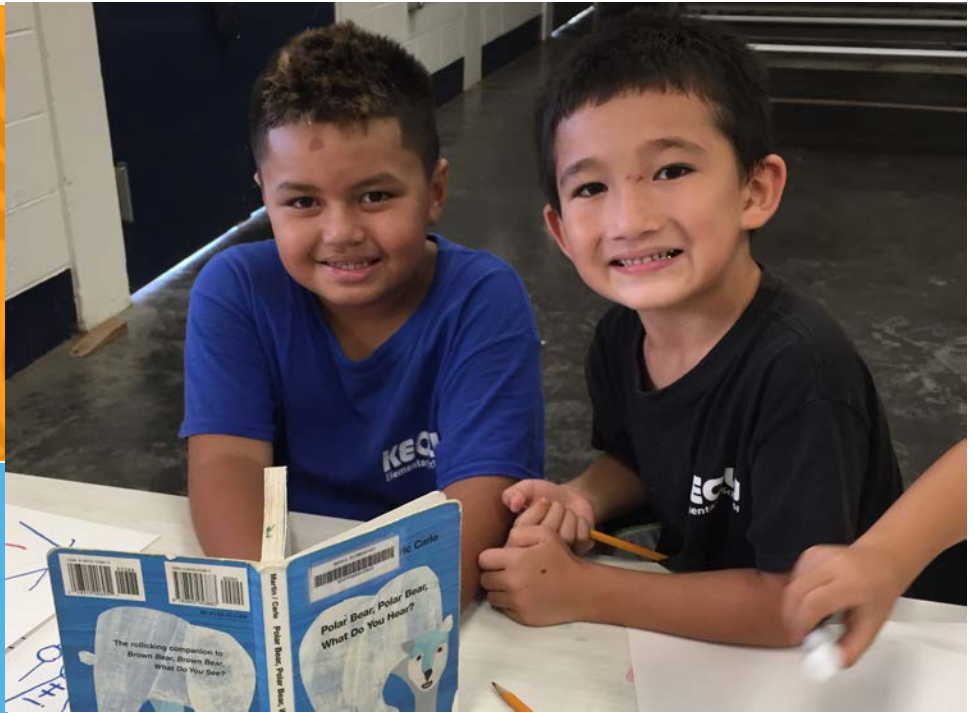

CREATE A SPACE FOR LEARNING

- Equipped with a desk or table
- Equipped with school supplies needed

STRATEGY FOR THE WEEK:

Have you ever had an “off” day? Sure we all have. Have you been having an off day and heard from a friend or gotten a word of encouragement and it instantly got better?

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RECIPE OF THE WEEK

Pumpkin Muffins

1 3/4 cup flour
 3/4 cup sugar
 1/2 cup brown sugar
 1 tsp. baking soda
 1/2 tsp. salt
 2 tsp. cinnamon
 1/4 tsp ground cloves
 1/4 tsp. nutmeg
 2 eggs
 1 can (15 oz.) pumpkin puree
 1/2 cup coconut oil (melted)
 1 tsp. vanilla

Preheat oven to 375 degrees.

Stir together all dry ingredients.
 Whisk together all wet ingredients and add to dry ingredients. Mix just until well blended (don't over mix). Fill muffin cups until nearly full. Bake 20-25 minutes. Enjoy!

• VR Tour: Waikalua Loko I'a Fri, Dec. 4th 6-6:30pm

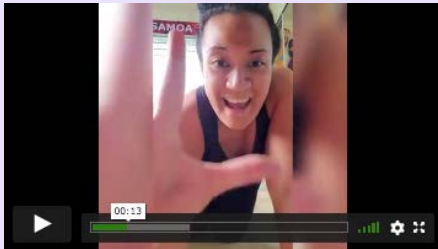
